In the last half year, she has experienced what it means to be an outsider of this community while at the same time she has observed the society, its members, and their weaknesses. Her lack of power has so far hindered her to change her status, but she is determined to find an angle. She is egoistic and manipulative, but she is not evil in the sense that she wants to see the colony fail. She simply tries to see her wants fulfilled by using the situation at hand without planning too far ahead.</p>
	<p>Inquisitor Dark Act 2 Scene 3 Act 3 Scene 3</p>	<p>Inquisitor Dark had been sent to the planet by the high inquisition on earth to aid the administrator and make sure that the settlements there don't fail. Her actual mission, which she keeps secret, is to make sure that the colonies supply earth with resources and don't become independent. She is a mysterious woman and a great authority, although she prefers to act in the background. She gets more and more involved in the witch hunt failing to see her own hand in the destruction of the colony. When talking the others she is calm but assertive, polite but not necessarily friendly; she is always surrounded by an aura of authority.</p>
	<p>Community Leader Narwit Act 1 Scene 2 Act 1 Scene 3 Act 3 Scene 2 Act 3 Scene 3</p>	<p>Narwit is a rather narrow-minded individual who has come into power by buying it. Before he moved to Salem, his business made him rich, of which he does not like to disclose the details. His biggest concern is his standing in the community which he sees threatened by other powerful members. In order to gain his position, he had to leave behind his business and invest most of his fortune, which makes him envious of the wealthier settlers. This he expresses in constant complaints.</p>
	<p>Brandi-Lynn Act 1 Scene 1 Act 1 Scene 4 Act 3 Scene 4</p>	<p>Brandi-Lynn has been Abigail's best friend ever since they went on the Salem mission craft together thinking themselves in the same position. She is an indentured servant, meaning she had to pay with her freedom for the journey to Planet X. She has been assigned as a servant to the Avarish family to work off her debt. Although she still believes in the promise that, when she has paid off her debts, she will be free and happy, she is not gullible but quite smart.</p>
	<p>Joe Tyrman Act 2 Scene 1 Act 2 Scene 3 Act 2 Scene 4 Act 3 Scene 2 Act 3 Scene 3</p>	<p>This man believes himself to be the righteous frontier man. He might have read too many books on pioneers during the colonization of America and idolizes the brave, humble, and honest farmer on whose back this colony is going to be build. He despises most other members of the community because he thinks them lazy and gullible, since he is the only one who knows the truth. At home, he behaves like a patriarch, commanding his wife, Elly Tyrman, and neglecting his three children. He has had an affair with Abigail, the Tyrmans' former servant. While he sees everyone else's faults, he thinks his wife should let him off the hook for this one. His main motivations are frustration and anger, of which he has a lot.</p>
	<p>Administrator Act 3 Scene 1 Act 3 Scene 2 Act 3 Scene 3</p>	<p>The planet's administrator, issued by the central government on earth to keep the different colonies on Planet X working and in line. When the trials start in the colony of Salem, they see the opportunity to gain more influence and power but soon find themselves in an all or nothing situation: If they let any doubt arise, they are finished. They are extremely sure of themselves and cannot imagine anyone having more expertise, except for the Inquisitor, maybe.</p>

Medium	Elly Tyrman Act 2 Scene 1 Act 3 Scene 3	Mrs Tyrman embodies everything that her husband wants to see in his wife: She is obedient, austere, and humble. Although that is because she has always been under her husband's thumb as well as trying to avoid his choleric outbursts. When her husband lands in jail, she starts to see how little he has done for her; though this character arc is rather subtle.
	Dolly Act 1 Scene 1 Act 1 Scene 4 Act 2 Scene 4 Act 3 Scene 2	Another indentured servant who has come to the colony for its promise of an eventual free and happy life. She has been taken on by the Tyrmans, after they had thrown out Abigail. She is easily manipulated and often afraid but finds self-worth in her work at the court.
	Licksby Act 2 Scene 3 Act 3 Scene 1 Act 3 Scene 2 Act 3 Scene 3	Licksby is an opportunist who has been recruited by the Administration to arrest all the accused. This is a welcome position for them as they have been a looked-down-upon loser but are now in a position of power. They are not very smart but cunning and should not be underestimated.
	Mary-June Dolcezza Act 2 Scene 2	The most respected member of the Salem colony. She is the embodiment of calm authority, kindness, and family orientation. With eleven children she has done more than her duty for the colony, which earns her both respect and envy.
	Geb Avarish Act 1 Scene 3 Act 3 Scene 4	Geb is the richest and greediest man in Salem. He is most interested in the resources that are to be unearthed on the planet, and that is what he came to Salem for. He is less interested in his family, and a bit disappointed in his wife. His fortune has bought him a lot of influence.
	Millicent Avarish Act 1 Scene 3 Act 2 Scene 2	Millicent Avarish is Geb's wife and the richest of the Salem wives; though she feels that this is not reflected in the way she is treated in the colony. She is envious, especially of Mary-June, whom she resents for having so many children while all hers died. She is also afraid of possible consequences for not having a healthy family, resentment by the colony that is.
	Host Stella Prologue	One of the two show hosts commenting on the media spectacle that is the settling of Salem Colony. Stella is a little more serious than her co-host Gary but does never lose her pose and always wears a happy face.
	Host Gary Prologue	One of the two show hosts commenting on the media spectacle that is the settling of Salem Colony. Gary is the punster of the duo, but his jokes are questionable at best. Gary is slightly less secure than her co-host but counters this with loads of (fake) charisma.
Minor	Ynanna Act 1 Scene 1	Servant to the Narwit household. She is street-smart and there are rumors that she possesses occult skills, rumors she spread herself to sell those skills.
	Phoebe Act 1 Scene 4	Community Leader Narwits daughter and Abigail's cousin. She is easily manipulated by Abigail into helping her with the allegations.
	Naima (Look Phoebe)	The Avarishs' daughter and Phoebe's friend. She as well is helping Abigail, who blackmailed her.
	Judge Act 3 Scene 1 Act 3 Scene 2	The colony's judge who reports to the Administrator. The judge is eager in the trials and believes Abigail's every word.
	Candice Act 1 Scene 2	Candice is a gullible and scared servant working off her debts for the medical department. She is recruited by Abigail.
	Tony Dolcezza Act 2 Scene 3	Mary-June's husband and very respected community man. Dixon's best friend.

	Dixon Muski Act 2 Scene 3	Rich landowner in Salem and always keen on being right. He is outspoken and honest, which gets him into trouble.
	Dolores Muski (Look Rebecca)	Dixon's wife and respected community member.
